For registered campers, we will be sending updated invoices out via email the week of April 6 and payments are expected on or before May 1, 2020. This deadline has not changed.

The summer 2020 cancellation deadline has been moved to June 1, 2020. You may either get a credit for the 2021 summer or a refund of monies paid less a \$150 cancellation fee. Should the social distancing continue and the authorities advise against summer camp operations, we will offer the option of either a credit for the 2021 summer or a full refund.

Those already registered should create their skill schedules and sign up for off campus trips. Links have been made available by mail, email, and online through Bunk1 (click on Forms).

We are mailing the health history form to registered campers. The health history is completed by the parent/legal guardian. We will not require a physician’s exam for the 2020 summer. If your camper has a physician guided treatment plan, please share that with our camp health care professionals.

By the week of April 6, all summer prep materials will be available by accessing your Bunk1 account.
