

## 2022 Camper Dates & Details

### February 2022

We begin publishing a series of summer prep materials. Keep watch on social media platforms and email inboxes and spam folders.

Skill placement is an ongoing effort beginning in February with the release and acceptance of skill selections forms. <http://linktr.ee/camphollymont>

Much like a giant 3-D puzzle, skill placement has many dimensions to be considered, and is subject to change as the skill selection sheets are received and the staff is hired. Skill schedules will be handed out on Monday morning prior to 1st skill.

### February or early March 2022 - Cluster Placement

Cluster preferences are initially shared when the camper is first registered.

**If you would like to make or update cluster placement requests in February or early March, you may use the “Cluster Requests and Parent’s Perspective” form on Bunk1.**

We are moving to a new registration software system (Circuitree) sometime in March or early April. Information from the Bunk1 system will be transferred. Once the Circuitree registration system is operational, you will login there and add or make changes to your cluster preferences. **If you make a cluster request in the new Circuitree system, you must provide the email address of the camper’s parent or guardian. They will automatically receive an invitation to approve your cluster request.**

Camp Hollymont reserves the right to place each camper in the cluster the Camp feels is best. Girls within the cluster are approximately the same age and grade. Hollymont works to accommodate a maximum of two requests. No more than three girls from the same hometown can be in one cluster. Campers must be staying the same length of time and parents must agree on the request. Cluster requests are for girls to be in the same cluster, not the same room. While careful consideration is given to each request, the final decision rests with the Camp. We ask that you support Hollymont’s final decision regarding your camper’s cluster assignment.

### March 1, 2022 - Cancellation deadline

2022 summer payments are refundable until March 1, 2022 except for a \$300 per camper processing fee.

### March 1, 2022 – 50% of balance is due

Any past due account after March 15, 2022, will receive a follow up email/invoice and may result in cancellation of Camper’s enrollment with no refund of the deposit if we are unable to contact you.

### Between March 10 and April 15

We are moving to a new registration software system (Circuitree) sometime in March or early April. Information from the Bunk1 system will be transferred.

### **May 1, 2022 – Remaining balance is due.**

Families with a past due account after May 15, 2022, will receive a phone call. If we are unable to contact you, your camper's enrollment is subject to cancellation with no refund of the deposit.

### **May 1, 2022 - Health History and All Other Applicable Forms Due**

We are moving to a new software system in late March or early April. You should be able to input form information online. Details will be published when the new software system goes live.

### **CAMPER SPENDING**

Campers do not use cash at camp. Charges from the camp store, canteen, personal item requests, medical expenses, and small group activities are recorded on each camper's spending sheet.

When the Circuitree system is operational, you may add \$100 spending for a STARTER camper and/or \$125 spending for a CLASSIC camper. We will monitor and discuss your camper's spending with her and contact you if the spending limit presents a challenge for your camper. When the session ends, unused spending money will be refunded or applied to the outstanding balance. Spending account overages will be billed at the end of the session.

### **AIRPORT TRANSPORTATION**

We pick up from and deliver to both Asheville Regional Airport (AVL) and Greenville-Spartanburg Airport (GSP). Please bear in mind that the **airports are approximately two hours away from camp depending on traffic and weather conditions.** We must have sufficient advance notice for campers to be greeted by camp personnel.

**Please schedule arrival and departure flights between 10 a.m. and 2 p.m. We will likely only make one trip to each airport on opening and closing days.**

Outgoing flights will require us to depart 4 hours prior to the first boarding flight of the day.

Please contact our office the week before your daughter flies in to verify that she is on our airport arrival list.

Although most airlines offer an unaccompanied minor program, airline policies can change without notice. Please inquire with the individual airlines about their unaccompanied minor program when you purchase your ticket and again the week before daughter's scheduled flight. Ask specifically about escorts for connecting flights.

### **INSURANCE**

Please note that we do not carry health or accident insurance on campers. Campers must be covered under a policy provided from home. Medical bills incurred while at camp will be forwarded home for submission to your health insurance company.

## **SPIRITUAL EMPHASIS**

We believe that God weaves our personal and collective experiences into His narrative of love and redemption for the world. The Hollymont owners and directors are Christ-Followers and we select staff who model the life of a Christ-Follower. Together we seek to encourage campers to read and study their Bibles to learn how God has called people to Himself and to learn how He wants to work in our lives today. Campers are expected to treat others with kindness and respect, and to uphold the Hollymont ideals and policies so that Hollymont will be a place filled with friends, fun, faith, and loving encouragement.

## **PERSONAL PROPERTY AND CONDUCT**

Possession or use of tobacco products, alcoholic beverages, illegal drugs, improperly obtained prescription medications, knives/firearms/explosives are prohibited. Use of profanity, deliberate abuse of self or abuse of others (bullying, sexual harassment, and/or inappropriate touch) or their property, and leaving the Hollymont premises without the directors' permission are strictly forbidden.

Campers may not bring personal vehicles to camp.

**We request that campers leave animals, cell phones, digital cameras, iPods, iPads, laptop computers, DVD players, and other electronic equipment at home.** If campers choose to bring their personal sporting equipment to camp, some items may be left in their rooms (softball gloves and tennis racquets) while other items (archery bows, softball bats, etc.) will be stored securely. **We ask that all items be well marked with the camper's name.** WE ARE NOT RESPONSIBLE FOR ANY LOST OR STOLEN ITEMS.

## **CARE PACKAGES - NO FOOD OR GUM, PLEASE!**

The problems (allergic reactions, sanitation, hurt feelings, and poor eating habits) created by food packages far outweigh the joys of receiving them. Any food sent will be kept and sent home with your camper.

We encourage packages of books, games, and clothing. Please understand this policy is for the wellbeing and safety of your camper and her fellow campers.

## **RIGHT TO REFUSE AND EXPEL**

Camp Hollymont reserves and retains the right, at its sole discretion, to cancel, reject, and/or refuse the application, admission, and/or participation of a camper from the Camp and/or any of its programs. Camp Hollymont can exercise this right at any time, including expelling a camper while attending and/or participating in the Camp's programs. In the event that Camp Hollymont exercises this right, it may, at its sole discretion, retain or refund any and all deposits, fees, tuition, or other moneys paid for the camper to attend Camp Hollymont.
