

ALUMNAE CAMP TERMS OF SERVICE (Camp rate \$650)

A deposit of \$300 per person must accompany each camp application.

May 1, 2022 Cancellation deadline

2022 deposits or payments are refundable until 5/1/22 except for a \$100 per processing charge.

May 1, 2022 Balance due

Any past due account after May 15, 2022 will result in cancellation of ALUMNAE camp enrollment with no refund of the deposit.

May 1, 2022 Mail and/or submit online all alumnae camp forms for 2022 summer.

PRE-CAMP COMMUNICATIONS

Once the application and deposit is received and accepted, we will send a confirmation via e-mail.

In mid April you'll receive more information relating to the alumnae camp via e-mail.

Hollymont's Alumnae camp begins with 2:00 p.m. check-in Sunday, July 10, 2022.

Departure will take place on Wednesday, July 13 after Morning Watch.

SPIRITUAL EMPHASIS

Camp Hollymont wants to allow alumnae to re-live favorite Hollymont memories and make new ones. Since Camp Hollymont exists to give each camper the opportunity to experience the joys of a Christ-centered life, our alumnae camp goal will be to encourage alumnae in their walk with Christ.

Immediately after breakfast on Monday, Tuesday, and Wednesday, alumnae will join with campers in the chapel for Morning Watch. After the evening activities, alumnae are invited to participate in alumnae devotions.

TRANSPORTATION

You may want to research three airports before making airline reservations. Asheville Regional Airport (AVL), Greenville-Spartanburg Airport (GSP), and Atlanta, GA (ATL). You would also need to rent a car for the trip from the airport to Hollymont. Travel time will be approximately 2 hours depending on airport and traffic.

POLICIES

Camp Hollymont is a place filled with friends, fun and loving encouragement. We believe that God weaves our personal and collective experiences into His narrative of love and redemption for the world. We encourage all camp participants to read and study their Bibles to learn how God has called people to Himself and to learn how He wants to work in our lives today. Alumnae are expected to treat others with kindness and respect, and to uphold the Hollymont ideals and policies.

We request that alumnae camp participants leave spouses and pets at home (or at least off-campus).

Part of the joy and benefit of the camp experience comes from “disconnecting from the real world”. To preserve that experience for our campers and your fellow alumnae and to protect the campers’ privacy, cell phones, digital cameras, iPods, iPads, laptop computers, DVD players, and other electronic equipment should be remain in your locked room. Any personal sporting equipment brought to camp should be left in your locked room or car when not in use. We ask that all items be well marked with your name. **WE ARE NOT RESPONSIBLE FOR ANY LOST OR STOLEN ITEMS.**

All medications (prescription and over-the counter) brought to camp must be secured in your locked room/car or in your immediate possession.

Possession or use of tobacco products, alcoholic beverages, illegal drugs, improperly obtained prescription medications, knives, firearms, and/or explosives is prohibited on the Camp Hollymont/ Rabun Gap School campus or when participating in Hollymont sponsored activities off-campus. I understand that alumnae camp participants are to refrain from use of profanity and deliberate abuse of self or abuse of others or their property.

Alumnae camp participants are expected to abide by the campus curfew hours set in place for safety of all those who live on the Camp Hollymont / Rabun Gap School campus. Personal vehicles are to be parked in designated areas. Gate hours and speed limits must be observed. Non-family campers are not allowed to ride in your vehicle nor is a Hollymont staff member allowed to operate your vehicle without the express permission of a Camp Hollymont director.

Camp Hollymont directors will conduct an investigation if they suspect that Camp Hollymont policy has been violated and have the right and the obligation to search any and all alumnae personal property to enforce policies related to the health and/or safety of Camp Hollymont campers, staff, and alumnae and/or Rabun Gap School guests and employees.
