Packing List and Packing Hints for CLASSIC Session Campers

Basically, bring play clothes - shorts and shirts. Late evenings and early mornings can be cool. Make sure all clothing and shoes are well marked with a laundry pen or name labels.

No laundry service is provided for 13-day campers. We have limited laundry facilities available at Hollymont for staff use. During the session we will monitor each cluster and wash a load of wet towels or dirty clothes as needed.

Hollymont camp colors are green and blue. You can pre-order and pick up your items on opening day. Please note that some quantities are limited and supply chains are uncertain. You can visit our pre-order form at: linktr.ee/camphollymont

Beds will not be furnished. Please bring sheets, bedspread/blanket, pillows, and pillow cases. We also suggest bringing an old sleeping bag/towel/blanket that can be used for a few of our outside activities where campers are lounging in the grass.

Clothing:

- 1 dress (Please no spaghetti straps or strapless dresses) Occasions: Sunday morning chapel, tea party
- Plenty of shorts and shirts
- Jeans
- 2 Sweatshirts
- Socks and underwear for your camper's entire stay plus 2 extra sets
- Pajamas
- 2 One-Piece Swimsuits (No tankinis) **If flying, PACK SWIMSUIT in carry-on bag for Sunday swim test.**
- 1 Raincoat and/or a light jacket
- 1 pair of Hiking shoes (any old, comfortable, walking shoe)
- At least 1 pair of tennis shoes
- 1 pair of dress shoes or dress sandals
- Shower shoes

Additional items:

- Drawstring bag, backpack, or day pack
- Washcloths and Towels
- Beach Towels for the Pool (also sold in our online camp store)
- Bible
- Stationery, Pens, Pencils (Pencils and stamps can also be purchased at camp)
- Clothes hangers
- Toiletry articles and a basket, bag, or container to carry toiletry items to/from the bathroom
- Flashlight and water bottle (we will have a limited supply of water bottles for sale at camp)
- Laundry Bag
- Sunscreen
- Sleeping bag (optional)
- Command Poster Strips, painter's tape, or sticky tac (for items camper wants to hang on her walls)
- Pillow and blanket or bedspread (Sheet size: Twin Extra Long)

Special Event items:

- SURPRISE EVENT (the staff doesn't even know the surprises we have up our sleeve!)
 - **A Session:** "Beads and Bling, it's a Mardi Gras thing!" (pack your purple, gold, and green....we can't wait to celebrate the Hollymont Krewe Queens!)
 - **B Session:** "Star Spangled Summer!" (show your American pride by wearing red, white, and blue!)
 - **C Session:** "All you need is love & tie-dye!" (Pack your brightest tie-dye attire and get ready for a groovy good time!)

Horseback Trail Riders - Riding helmet, long pants (riding pants or jeans), and shoes with heels and smooth surfaced soles.

Optional items:

Over the door hooks to hang towels - Tennis Racquet - Costumes, Music, and Instruments for talent show
Disposable/non-digital camera - Books to read - packable camp chair - clock - hairdryer

Share with your camper:

Our housing is air-conditioned. All outer doors have a keypad and campers will use it to access their building. We will print the code on their nametag.

Reminder:

Camp provides a unique opportunity for girls to disconnect from electronics and social media to enjoy simplicity and community. Therefore, we ask that telephone communication to or from home be limited to emergencies only. Otherwise, important lessons of independence and self-reliance beyond the home situation can be short-circuited by a quick call to or from home and the opportunity to escape from social pressures is lost.

We request that your camper refrain from bringing her cell phone, smart watch, and other means of accessing social media. You are always welcome to call with a question, concern, or suggestion. Since camp days are action-packed and staff members are often leading camper activities, the office staff will take a detailed message and have the appropriate staff return your call when the camp schedule permits.

If your camper is traveling alone and has a communication device, please instruct her to give the device to her counselor when she arrives at camp. It will be returned when your camper leaves camp. If your camper does not turn in her device on opening day and we have reason to believe she is in possession of such a device, we reserve the right to search and retrieve the item. If found, the device will be returned at the end of camp. We ask for your cooperation in maintaining this vital aspect of the camping experience.
